Cooperative Agreement No. GHS-A-00-06-00010-00
Associate Awards

The Health Systems 20/20 (HS 20/20) is a Leader with Associates cooperative agreement. Additional “associate” cooperative agreements can be negotiated and awarded by USAID Missions or Bureaus to support the same objectives as the Leader agreement.

The requesting office or SO Team in the Mission (or Bureau in USAID/W) first consults with the CTO in Global (Karen Cavanaugh and Yogesh Rajkotia) to ensure the technical leadership role of Global and the appropriate use of the mechanism. After receiving Global's concurrence, the appropriate Mission personnel shall request the recipient to provide an application to the mission. The Mission has the discretion to decide whether or not to award the Associate grant. Once the Associate Agreement is awarded, the Mission activity manager is the CTO for the Associate Agreement.

Associate agreements:

- Can be awarded at anytime during the life of the Leader Agreement and continue for 5 years beyond the end of the Leader Agreement (2006-2011)
- Are additional to the Leader Agreement’s ceiling of \$125,000,000
- Can be for any value; there is no minimum or ceiling
- Are awarded to the Leader recipient team; they are not competed
- Are managed by the Mission or Bureau CTO and Agreement Officer
- Consist of the Associate Award form (2 pages) and two attachments: A) Schedule and B) the Program Description
- Are subject to the standard provisions of the Leader award, and
- Are required to provide a copy of all program and financial reports to the technical office that funded the Associate award and to provide a copy of all program reports to the Global CTO.
